



## Grade 3&4 Curriculum Overview – Unit 4, 2022

### **Unit of Inquiry**

During this unit of inquiry 'How the World Works, students will be learning how advances in science can impact the survival of living things. Students will be inquiring into how different living things have different life cycles and how they depend on each other and the environment to survive. Students will be able to choose different living things life cycles and will use their research skills to gain new knowledge.

### **Inquiry into Reading**

As part of this unit of inquiry, students will be learning about the text structure and organisation of different types of text. Students will be learning how to summarise different texts using graphic organisers. Students will learn skills to support them in analysing, interpreting and synthesising their learning by sharing their prior knowledge and what they have learnt from reading.

### **Inquiry into Writing**

In writing this unit we will be focusing on explanation, recount and information texts. Students will be able to build on their knowledge from reading to support them in using scientific and topic specific vocabulary. Students will follow the writer's process by planning, drafting, revising, editing and publishing different text types.

### **Inquiry into Numeracy**

During this unit of inquiry, students will be learning about fractions and decimals. Students will have the opportunity to learn about fractions in real life contexts, such as, half price of different items. Students will also be learning about comparing and ordering fractions by creating a fraction wall. In Measurement and Geometry, students will be learning about volume, capacity, mass and telling the time.
